

**Limestone Township Supervisors Meeting
February 6, 2024**

Meeting opened at 6:30 this evening.

The Secretary/Treasurer Report:

Brian made a motion to approve the February minutes which was seconded by Rich. All in favor, motion carries.

Timesheets and bills were signed.

Stanley made a motion to have Andrew Keister removed from all Limestone Township Bank accounts at Mifflinburg Bank & Trust in Mifflinburg and add Brian Haines as the new signor to those same accounts and require by Resolution (2024-2) that the Tax Collector provide a copy of monthly bank statements for review by the supervisors which was seconded by Rich.
