March 5, 2024**

Meeting opened at 6:30 this evening.

The Secretary/Treasurer Report:

Rich made a motion to approve the February minutes which was seconded by Brian. All in favor, motion carries.

Timesheets and bills were signed.

Stanley made a motion to pay out \$1250.00 to New Berlin Borough and cancel the Winter Maintenance Agreement which was seconded by Rich. All in favor, motion carries.

Rich made a motion to pay out the Firefighter Tax Credit which was seconded by Brian. All in favor, motion carries. Recipients of the credit are Jerry Johnson, Brad Benfer and Kale Gisewite.
