

**Limestone Township Supervisors Meeting  
May 6, 2025**

Meeting opened at 6:30 this evening.

The Secretary/Treasurer Report:

Rich made a motion to approve the April minutes which was seconded by Brian. All in favor, motion carries.

The Livic plans for the Penns bridge were discussed with the three-sided versus four-sided design. The three sided is approximately \$79,00 and the four sided is slightly higher. The document was signed to move forward with the project.

Planning Commission: Jim reported that they recommended granting the exemption to David Sensenig for building 5 feet into the setback. He also asked the Supervisors if Jenna could attend the next Planning Commission meeting for help with questions that will be coming up that they will most likely need help with.

Ron Quinn reported that according to David Hummel, no one has flushed the hydrants for several years. Andrew asked that Sharon Koppel be appointed to the Water Authority. Rich made a motion to approve the appointment which was seconded by Brian. All in favor, motion carries. Ron had questions about rates that residents are being charged in Limestone versus rates for West Buffalo. Jenna is going to look at whether or not the Authority can be dissolved. There are also some missing documents that need to be found for the Authority if possible.
